### AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW

#### Week Ending 10 September 2021 (Week 10)

The AWEX EMI finished  $29\phi$  higher (+2.2%) in Australian currency and  $31\phi$  higher (+3.2%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle in Week 10.

31,698 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 34,184 bales last sale. 9.1% of the offering was passed in after 6.7% of the potential offering was withdrawn prior to sale. 28,826 bales were sold.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$44.3 million (\$1,536 per bale), taking the season total to \$349.4 million (\$1,565 per bale). The number of bales sold at auction this season is now 21.8% greater than in 2020/21.

The New Zealand Merino Company also offered 1,298 bales in Melbourne on Wednesday, of which 13.4% were passed in.

The market opened strongly in both currencies on Tuesday (and particularly in Fremantle) before steadying on Wednesday. Tuesday's rise was expected, as there had been reports of good inquiry following the close of the previous week's sale.

The week finished with good gains among the Merinos, of which the greatest gains were from 17 to 20 microns. The crossbreds did less well with falls in most micron ranges.

The US Exchange Rate finished 0.59¢ (0.8%) higher to close at 73.84¢ on Wednesday.

In the usual pattern, buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for Europe and India.

Looking ahead, offerings for the coming three sales are continuing to be well up on last year. They are currently expected to range from 37,987 bales to 41,803 bales and to be 71.5% more than in the same period last year. The forecast progressive difference to Week 13 is for offerings to be 37.3% up on last year.

In other countries, the South African Cape Wools Indicator was down by 1.6% since last week against a 3.1% appreciation of the Rand against the US Dollar and a 2.4% appreciation against the Euro.




