Week Ending 11 June 2021 (Week 50)

It was another good week, when the AWEX EMI finished a further 50¢ higher (+3.7%) in Australian currency and 38¢ higher (+3.7%) in US currency at sales in Week 50. The closing EMI of 1393¢ was 50¢ above the previous week and created a new high for the season.

36,288 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 38,590 bales last sale. 4.1% of the offering was passed in after 5.0% of the potential offering was withdrawn prior to sale. 34,816 bales were sold.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$58.2 million (\$1,672 per bale), taking the season total to \$2.041 billion (\$1,398 per bale). The number of bales sold at auction this season is now 24.5% greater than in 2019/20.

The market got off to an excellent start on Tuesday, that continued at a slightly lesser level on Wednesday. There were rises across all wool types and micron ranges on both days, with the greatest rises continuing to be at the finer end of the Merinos. The average AWEX Micron Price Guide was up by 105ϕ (4.1%) at 16.5 microns.

The crossbreds and the oddments did not miss out either, with their best price gains for some weeks.

The US Exchange Rate was relatively unchanged again when it finished 0.02¢ (0.0%) lower to close at 77.40¢ on Wednesday.

In the usual pattern, buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for Europe and India.

Looking ahead, offerings for the coming three sales are expected to range from 32,490 bales to 45,341 bales and to be well above the volumes the same period last year. The forecast progressive difference to Week 53 is 21.1%.

In other countries, the South African Cape Wools Indicator was up by 1.5% since last week against a 1.4% appreciation of the Rand against the US Dollar and a 1.6% appreciation against the Euro.




