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Week Ending 14 May 2021 (Week 46)

The AWEX EMI finished at 1306¢, 13¢ lower (-1.0%) in Australian currency and 12¢ lower (-1.2%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle in Week 46.

49,771 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 47,558 bales last sale. 12.0% of the offering was passed in after 4.8% of the potential offering was withdrawn prior to sale, leaving 43,808 bales as sold.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$66.1 million (\$1,509 per bale), taking the season total to \$1.809 billion (\$1,380 per bale). The number of bales sold at auction this season is now 19.0% greater than in 2019/20 due a combination of larger offerings and a higher clearance rate.

The market eased slightly on Tuesday and Wednesday before closing on an unchanged basis on Thursday when the US Exchange Rate fell by 0.86¢ on the day. Changes in the average AWEX Merino Micron Price Guides (MPGs) showed little difference across the micron ranges, while there were larger downward shifts among the crossbred wools

The US Exchange Rate finished $0.16 \notin (-0.2\%)$ lower over the week to close at $77.09 \notin$ on Thursday.

In the usual pattern, buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for Europe and India. The latest data from the Australian Bureau of Statistics shows that 86.8% of Australia's wool exports went to China in the July to March period.

Looking ahead, the expected offerings for the coming three sales continue to be well ahead of last year, in this case by 129%. They are expected to range from 37,530 bales to 45,929 bales compared with 15,400 to 21,100 in the same period last year. The forecast progressive difference to Week 49 is +16.1%.

In other countries, the South African Cape Wools Indicator was up by 0.9% since last week against a 0.6% appreciation of the Rand against the US Dollar and a 0.1% depreciation against the Euro.

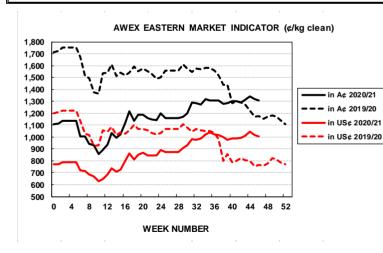

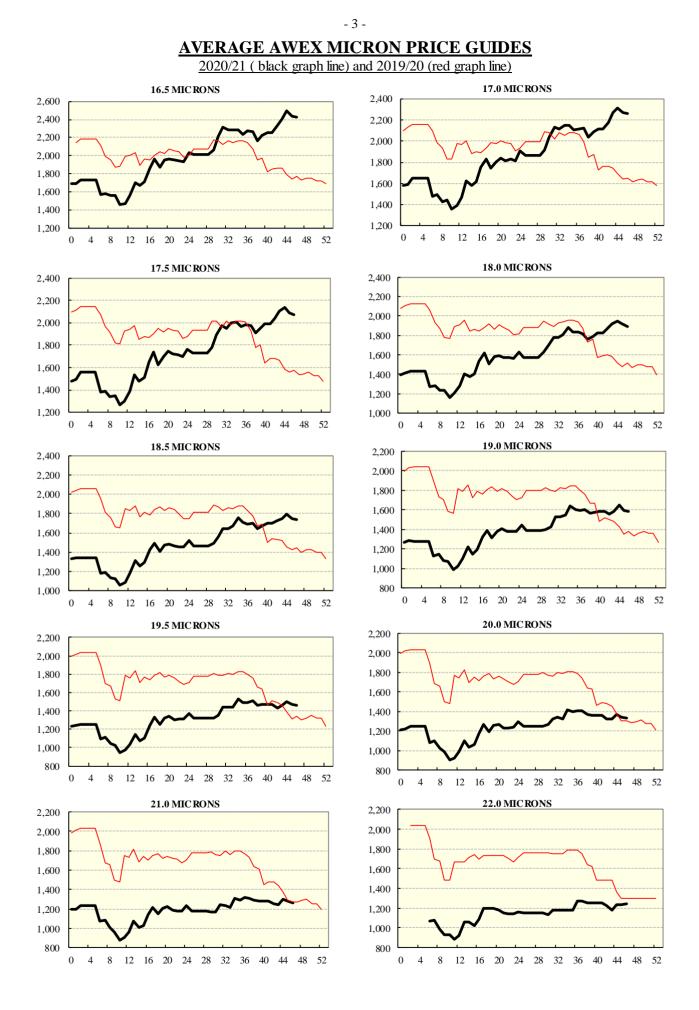

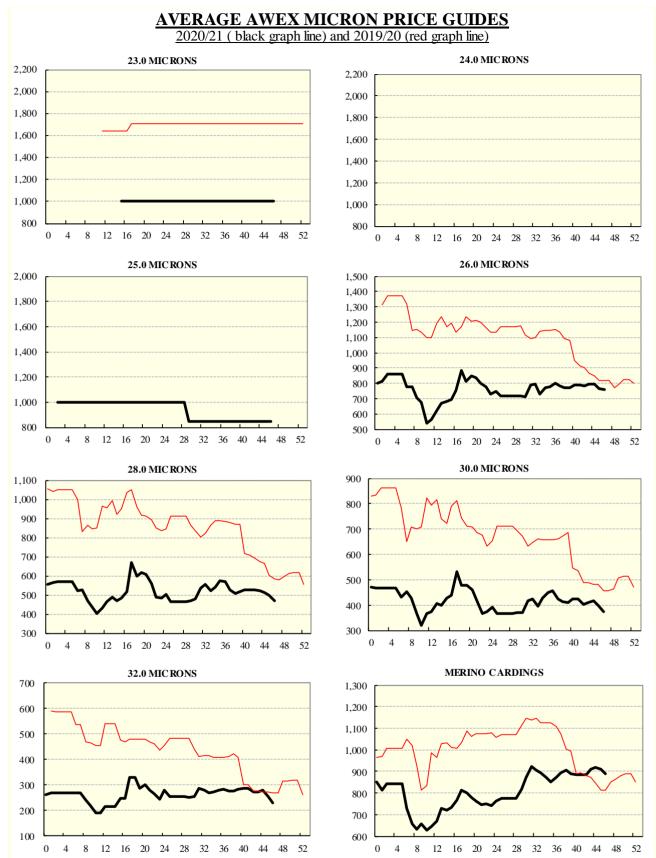
