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AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW

Week Ending 20 January 2023 (Week 29)

The AWEX EMI finished 8¢ higher (+0.6%) in Australian currency and 3¢ higher (+0.3%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle in Week 29.

47,343 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 50,469 bales last sale. 5.7% of the offering was passed in after 5.0% of the potential offering was withdrawn prior to sale. 44,631 bales were sold. The Pass-In rate 5.7% was one of the lower values for the season.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$67.9 million (\$1,521 per bale), taking the season total to \$1.242 billion (\$1,576 per bale). The number of bales sold at auction this season is now 2.4% greater than in 2021/22.

This week's sale opened on a positive note, with increases across all Merino, and the finer Crossbred micron ranges and types. The greatest gains were from 17 to 19 microns. Wednesday's market saw the EMI rise again, but by a smaller amount before easing on Thursday when only Melbourne sold.

The US Exchange Rate rose over the early part of the inter-sale period before falling on Thursday. Overall, it fell by $0.19 \, \phi \, (-0.3\%)$ to close at $69.04 \, \phi$ on Thursday.

Buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for India and Europe

Looking ahead, offerings for the coming three sales are expected to range from 42,040 bales to 46,535 bales and to be 0.2% less than in the same period last year. The forecast progressive difference to Week 32 is for 0.5% more bales.

In other countries, the Cape Wools Indicator rose by 4.4% when sales resumed in South Africa this week after the Christmas/New Year break. The South Africa/US Exchange Rate rose by 0.15% during the break.

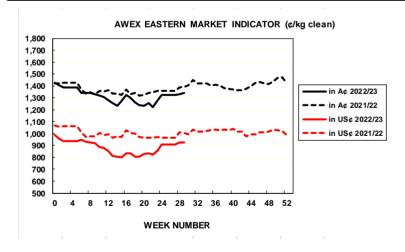

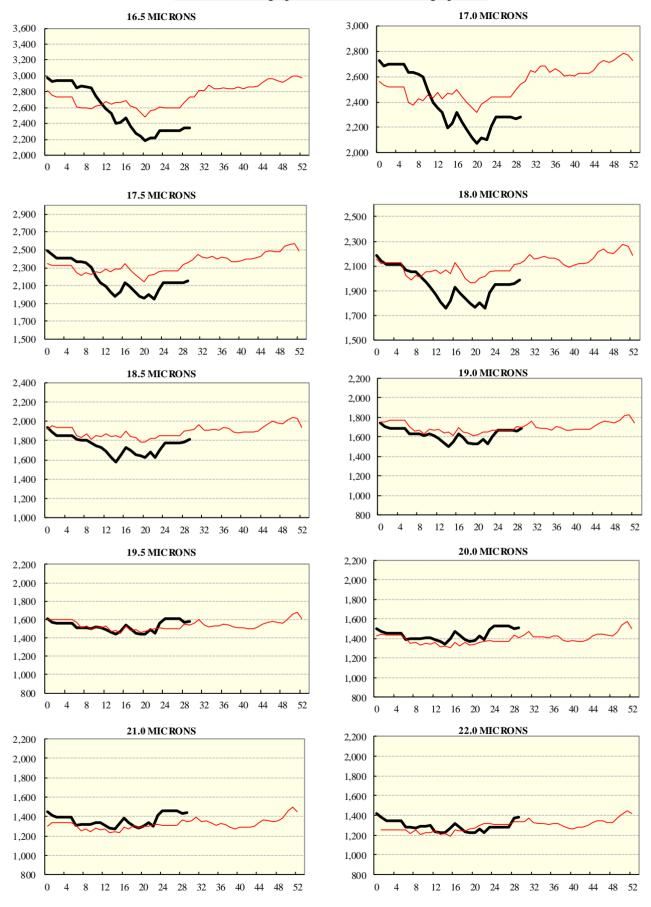
