AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW

Week Ending 26 March 2021 (Week 39)

The AWEX EMI finished 8ϕ higher (+0.6%) in Australian currency and 23ϕ lower (-2.3%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle in Week 39 in a market that was influenced by a falling US Exchange Rate.

38,564 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 48,409 bales last sale. 9.4% of the offering was passed in after 13.2% of the potential offering was withdrawn prior to sale, leaving 34,942 bales as sold. It was the first sale since the first week of February in which less than 40,000 bales were on offer.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$50.5 million (\$1,445 per bale), taking the season total to \$1.442 billion (\$1,358 per bale). The number of bales sold at auction this season is now 6.7% greater than in 2019/20.

There were gains in the average AWEX Merino Price Guides (MPGs) from 16.5 to 19.5 microns, which were greatest at the fine end and progressively falling away towards 19.5 microns. There were then slight falls from 20 through to 22 microns. Crossbred prices made small gains, except at 30 microns, were there was a small downward movement.

The US Exchange Rate finished 2.26¢ (-2.9%) lower to close at 76.01¢ on Wednesday.

Buyers for China continued to dominate, with support from buyers for India and Europe.

In other countries, the South African Cape Wools Indicator was down by 0.7% since last week against a 0.5% appreciation of the Rand against the US Dollar and a 1.2% appreciation against the Euro.

Looking ahead, the offering for the coming week is back up to 48,829 bales. It is the last sale before Easter and is followed by a break in the week after Easter. The current forecast offering in the week after the break is for 48,764 bales which would take the progressive difference to 14.4%




