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#### **WOOL MARKET REVIEW**

Week Ending 26 November 2021 (Week 21)

The AWEX EMI finished 17¢ higher (+1.3%) in Australian currency and 4¢ higher (+0.4%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle in Week 21.

36.814 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 40,241 bales last sale. 7.1% of the offering was passed in after 6.7% of the potential offering was withdrawn prior to sale. 34,203 bales were sold.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$54.9 million (\$1,604 per bale), taking the season total to \$937.7 million (\$1,611 per bale). The number of bales sold at auction this season is now 22.5% greater than in 2020/21.

The New Zealand Merino Company also offered 911 bales in Melbourne on Wednesday, of which 24.9% were passed in.

The market opened on a cautious note on Tuesday, with the fine wools in the South being the only ones to finish in positive territory. AWEX reported that Tuesday's results in the South included gains of 20 to 40¢ achieved by some Speciality Non-Mulesed lots of 17.5 microns and finer.

Wednesday saw the market lift strongly across all types and micron ranges among the Merinos, but remain relatively unchanged among the Crossbreds.

The US Exchange Rate continued its downward movement of recent weeks when finished 0.64¢ (-0.9%) lower to close at 72.09¢ on Wednesday.

Buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for Europe and India.

Looking ahead, offerings for the coming three sales are expected to range from 41,050 bales to 42,130 bales and to be 13.0% more than in the same period last year. The forecast progressive difference to Week 24 is +23.5%.

In other countries, the South African Cape Wools Indicator was up by 3.1% since last week against a 2.9% depreciation of the Rand against the US Dollar and a 2.0% depreciation against the Euro.

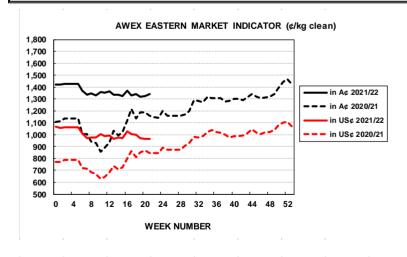

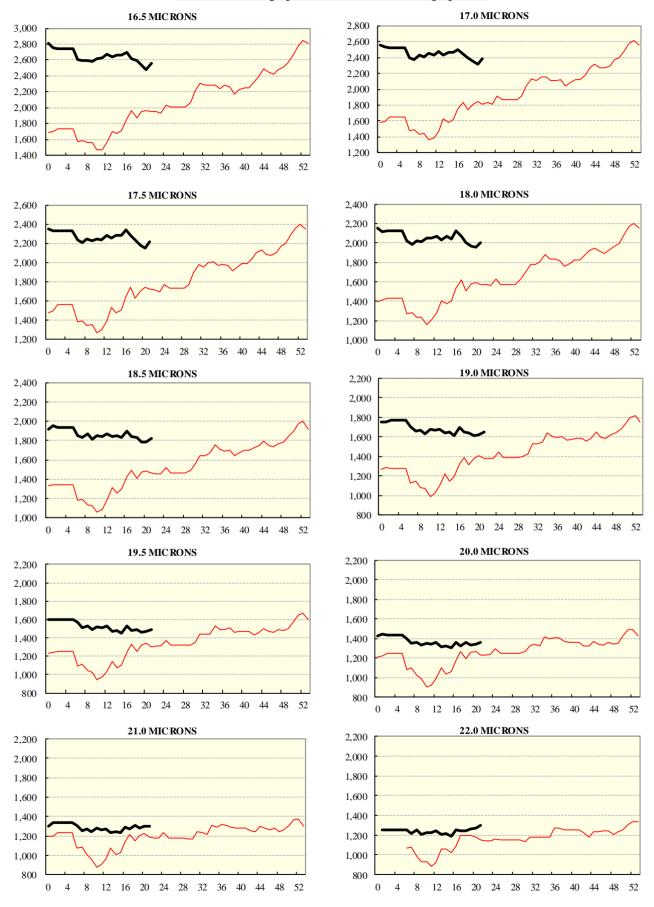
